HISTORY RUN is an educational “platformer” action runner that guides players through 17 eras of American history, combining fast-paced gameplay with historically accurate environments, events, and collectible artifacts. Players retrieve historical objects scattered across time and return them to a virtual museum, reinforcing learning through discovery and play.

Designed by a historian rather than a traditional game studio, **HISTORY RUN** emphasizes narrative context, visual immersion, and historical accuracy without relying on lectures or quizzes.
